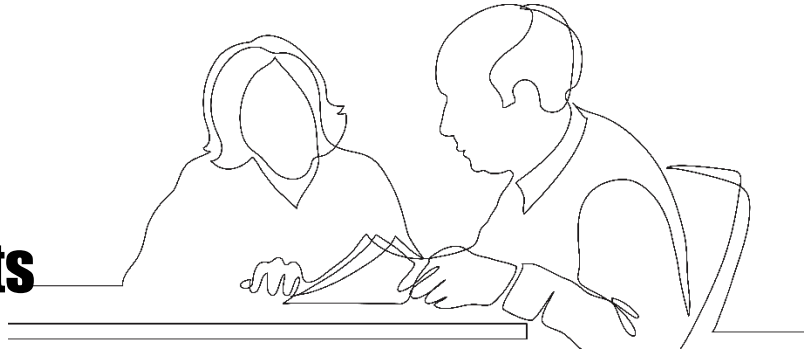


Health Services and Assistance for Non-Covered Participants

1. Affordable Care Act

You may be eligible for subsidized health coverage through the Health Insurance Exchange. www.healthcare.gov.

2. AFL-CIO Medicare Advantage

A Medicare Advantage plan that offers health coverage for participants aged 65+ with no DGA-Producer Health Plan coverage. Benefits include hearing, vision and Rx gap coverage, along with nationwide access to providers.
